Workshop Description

The three-day workshop will include the "Introduction to Childbirth for New Doulas" as well as the 16-hour DONA International-approved Birth Doula Workshop. The workshop includes a printed version of your DONA International Birth Doula manual and access to the "Birth Doula Workshop Google Classroom" where you can find out power-point presentations and class handouts.

Day One: Introduction to Childbirth for New Doulas -7 hrs.

This class fills the requirement for DONA International's "Observation of a Childbirth Preparation" series. Topics to be covered: Basic anatomy & physiology of pregnancy, stages, and phases of labor, medication options, discomforts of pregnancy, and all general topics covered within a childbirth education class.

Day Two: Birth Doula Workshop -8 hrs.

Presents the dynamics of labor and birth, how to be a skilled companion during childbirth, and how to soothe and comfort a laboring woman. Topics to be covered: Introduction to labor support, prenatal contact between doula and client, emotional support, comfort measures, and the business aspects of a doula practice.

Day Three: Birth Doula Workshop -8 hrs.

Covers in-depth labor support strategies, the role of the doula within the medical framework, guidelines for pre- and postnatal contact with clients, how to deal with problem labors and unexpected outcomes, how to contribute to breastfeeding success, and specific tips for setting up practice as a doula. Topics to be covered: cesarean birth, VBAC, postpartum contact between doula and client, difficult labors, the newborn and breastfeeding.



Workshops typically run Friday early afternoon - evening, & all day Saturday and Sunday. However, these hours may vary by workshop depending upon the availability of the meeting space. Our workshops will be held within a 20-mile radius of the location listed. Please be advised that the EXACT location is usually determined within two weeks of the workshop since the location is dependent upon class size. You will receive a confirmation email with all of the workshop information once the location is determined. *Non-mobile infants are welcome to join the workshop with mom.

You will receive two certificates after completion of the full three days. One certificate will confirm you have attended the required Introduction to Childbearing Course (Held on the first day). The second certificate confirms your attendance & completion of the DONA Approved Birth Doula Workshop (Held on day two & three). Certificates will be distributed at the end of the third day.
